

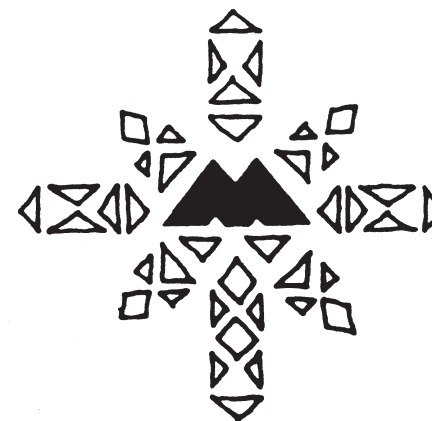
BOOKING AND ACCOMMODATION RULES

- Senior Associate Members have the same booking rights and obligations as Members.
- Associate membership benefits apply to the associate member only.
- A member's spouse and eligible children (see below) may book during the preferential booking period. Spouse includes de facto.
- A member may book for a non-member companion to accompany them to the Lodge for up to one week per season at member's rates. The companion must share the member's room. Beyond the allocation of one week per season, non-members rates will apply. Such bookings will be accepted in the preferential booking period.
- Children are defined as being 17 years of age or under at the commencement of the period booked. Members' children over the age of 17 years pay full non-members' rates UNLESS they are FULL TIME students, in which case Members' rates will apply until they reach the age of 21.
- A child of 5 years or under may share a room with both parents gratis, but the parents must provide all meals for the child.
- Children may only stay at the lodge in the care of a parent or guardian who must ensure that proper consideration is shown to other guests.
- No person is to stay at either lodge without having a prepaid, confirmed booking. Please present your booking confirmation slip to the lodge manager or hut captain upon request.

- Guests at both lodges provide their own towels and linen.
- Guests at Perisher Lodge provide and prepare their own meals.
- All guests are required to assist with the daily cleaning and operation of the lodges including bathrooms, fireplaces and other common areas. Guests are responsible for making their own beds and for the daily cleaning and maintenance of their rooms, including ensuite bathrooms, if provided. Lodges should be thoroughly cleaned and tidied on the day of departure and blankets should be folded and evenly distributed amongst the bedrooms.

Note for the winter season: the management will arrange for the rooms at Thredbo to be cleaned professionally when vacated. Cleaning costs are included in the tariff.

- Members have preferential booking for the Christmas - New Year period and for Easter up until one month before those holidays.
- Members may claim a rebate of \$100 of their subscription against any booking during the year for their own accommodation.

MEMBERS PREFERENTIAL BOOKING PERIOD

Members and eligible persons have absolute preference for bookings made before 21st April, 2009. See Rules on back page. Applications from members' friends and other non-members will not be processed before that date.

If you are the adult (18 years and over) son or daughter of a member, advise this on your booking application form and we will use our best endeavours to give your booking application preference over other non-members.

Associate members have preference after members but before non-members. Associate members pay members' tariffs.

Bookings during the preferential booking period are limited to one weekend and two weeks maximum per person.

BOOKING PROCEDURE

The Booking Manager will commence the processing of applications on 25th March, 2009.

Until then, **all applications must be by post only**, on the official form. All applications must be accompanied by a cheque for the full remittance due and a stamped, self-addressed envelope for return of booking confirmation slips.

Applications for accommodation from members or associates who have not paid their yearly subscriptions shall not be processed until such time as all outstanding monies are paid.

Each member family should submit separate booking forms. Block booking applications from groups of members cannot be accepted. Should you wish to book for the same period as another member, please submit concurrent but separate applications with an attached note explaining your wishes — every effort will be made to satisfy your requirements.

PERISHER WHOLE LODGE BOOKINGS

Members and associates may request a booking for Perisher on a 'whole lodge' basis for parties of up to 12 people. The member must accompany the party. Requests will be considered after the preferential booking period.

TELEPHONE BOOKINGS AND ENQUIRIES (02) 6457 6372

The Booking Manager will be available to take general telephone bookings and enquiries on and after 25th March, 2009. Please do not telephone before that date.

Prior to the ski season, times for telephone enquiries are strictly limited to **Wednesdays and Thursdays**, 7.00 p.m. to 8.30 p.m. only. During the season, telephone enquiries can be made at any time.

Telephone bookings will be pencilled in only and automatically cancelled unless confirmed in writing within seven days accompanied by full remittance and with a stamped, self-addressed envelope enclosed.

SCHOOL HOLIDAY BALLOT, BOTH LODGES

Due to demand for school holiday bookings, a ballot may be held to allocate accommodation at both lodges for the three-week period from Saturday 4th July to Friday 24th July.

The special procedure for bookings for this period is as follows:

- All applications must be in writing on the official form. Telephone applications will not be accepted.
- Only members, their spouses and eligible children may apply. Separate applications must be submitted for each member's family (i.e. a combined application from a group of members will not be accepted.)
- Each applicant is entitled to enter the ballot for a one full week period only. Please be sure to indicate your second and third booking period preference on your application form.
- The ballot will be limited to written applications received by the Booking Manager by 14th April.
- Members will be advised in writing of the result of the ballot. You may telephone the Booking Manager between 7.00 p.m. and 8.30 p.m. on or after 15th April, Wednesdays and Thursdays only, for such information, if you wish.
- Following the ballot, usual booking rules will apply to any vacancies remaining for the school holidays.

Members who were not successful in last year's ballot will be given priority in this year's ballot.

Every attempt will be made to ensure that each applicant's requirements are fulfilled.

BOOKING PERIODS

Bookings are generally available on a weekly basis, with check-in at 2.00 pm Saturdays, check-out at 10.00 am the following Saturday.

For five night bookings (at Thredbo only), check-in is available from 2.00 pm Sunday, check-out time is 10.00 am Friday.

Daily rates will apply to weekends and all other periods less than one week. Check-in is available from 2.00 pm on the arrival day. Check-out time is at 10.00 am on the departure day.

Summer bookings for Thredbo Lodge shall be made through the booking manager. Summer bookings for Perisher shall be made through Chris Brangwin (02) 4465 1955 or email cjbrangwin@ozemail.com.au.

Flexible booking periods are usually available at both lodges at the beginning and end of the season.

CANCELLATIONS

All cancellations must be confirmed in writing to the Booking Manager.

A fee will be charged on all cancellations, as follows, per person:

Minimum cancellation fee	— \$50.00
6 weeks or more notice	— \$50.00
Less than 6 weeks notice	— 50% of tariff due
Less than 4 weeks notice	— No refund

Cancellation notices will be deemed to be received on the day following posting of the notice.

Please allow at least thirty days for processing of refunds.

Payments may be made by cheque or Visa or Mastercard.
